



FLOREȘTI HIGHLIGHTS

- Floreşti commune lies at West site from Cluj-Napoca city, with direct conectivity links and proximity to major urban and regional infrastructure - DN1/ E60 and A3 highway.
- Population: approx. 60,000 inhabitants the largest commune by population in Romania with a very rapid increse trend in the last 10 years
- According to the World Bank (2020), Florești as a commune, has the youngest and most educated population in Romania – about 39% of workingage population have university education.
- Florești is an integral part of the Cluj Metropolitan Area, the most dynamic urban growth hub in Romania.



Economic Perspectives

- Rapid population growth provides strong demand for housing, services, retail, health, education, leisure etc.
- Key dominant sectors: construction, logistics, production and services related to metropolitan ecosistem.
- Major urban regeneration plan is in development in order to respond to community challenges: urban planning, infrastructure & mobility public services, green spaces, educational, cultural, leisure and sports facilities.
- Floreşti wants to position itself as a metropolitan hub of synergy between education and industrial sectors through industrial parks development projects and educational consolidation at the school and university level.

The objective of the sustainable mobility corridor is to connect the Cluj Metropolitan Area, through a large network of green corridors – pedestrian and cycling - structured on the East – West axis along the Somes River.

- Modern exhibition & event spaces, investigation & restoration & conservation laboratories, relaxation areas, green spaces.
- The project also provides for relaxation areas, green spaces, parking lots and specially arranged places for cultural and educational events
- The land dedicated to the project was offered by Floreşti City Hall.
- It is the first museum built from scratch in Romania in the last 100 years.
